

Our Program

It is our purpose to provide continue education programs to students who are unable to attend full-time classes. This is accomplished through our streamline program. We believe that we can offer the same Christian education.

Credit Hours

The minimum of two hours per week in the classroom and study at home is equivalent to the credit hour required for each course of study. We have adjusted our requirement for graduate and post-graduate degrees in an effort to keep the tuition to a minimum and allow our students ample time to complete his or her field of study. Our staff have chosen textbooks and materials and separating arduous minor information from major academic information. It is our position that the information can be obtained and retained by reading fewer books, provided that it is the right book.

What We Believe....

We believe the Bible to be inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16, 2nd Peter 1:21).

We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons – Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30).

We believe in the deity of Christ (John 10:33), His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35), His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26), His miracles (John 2:11), His vicarious and atoning death (1Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9), His resurrection (John 11:25, 1 Corinthians 14:4), His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19), and His personal returning power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11).

We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature, and that people are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood and Christ, and that only by God's grace and faith are we saved (John 3:16-21; John 5:24; Romans 3:23, 5:8-9, Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5).

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and lost: they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29). In the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Galatians 3:26-28). In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by who's indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13-14; 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20; Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).

Life Earned Credits

Faith in Action Bible College recognizes life learning experience and will issue credit for such experience. However, such credit must be determined by the **President** and the Administration of FIABC at the candidate's evaluation process.

Transferred Credits

Faith in Action Bible College reserves the right to allow or not to allow credits earned at other institutions for similar course taken at the institution. If credit is awarded, the candidate will be assessed at \$4.00 per credit hour. These hours may not exceed 60% of the required hours for graduation from Faith in Action Bible College.

Refund Policy

No refunds are given for **BOOK FEES.** A student must notify Faith in Action Bible College in writing of the intention to withdraw or drop a program.

- * You may pre-register at any time by filling out the application. The application fee is \$60.00. Upon arrival on the first night of class, it is required that all book fees are paid in full. You will be required to sign a contract for monthly payments for tuition and administration fees.

- a. A copy of your high school transcript or GED transcript or diploma
- b. Completed admission application

Policy and Commandments

- * The first semester begins in September and ends in December.
- * The second semester begins in January and ends in April.

1. Attendance

- a. All students are expected to attend every scheduled class.
- b. Students are expected to attend classes on time.
- c. Attendance is documented for each scheduled class meeting beginning with the first scheduled class, sign in sheet.
- d. When you have arrived for class, please make sure that you sign the attendance sheet and document your time of arrival.
- e. If you are going to be late, you must communicate with your instructor as to how late and why. This also applies to leaving class early. Inform your instructor, and document your departure time on the sign in/out sheet.
- f. If you are over thirty minutes late, you will be counted as absent with the exception of pre-approval from your instructor.
- g. Students are allowed two absences per semester.
- h. In the event of an emergency, the student must notify the instructor as soon as possible.
- i. **After four absences, the instructor may drop the student if the student does not make every effort to contact him or her.**
- j. If there are extenuating circumstances, the instructor has the authority to make an exception to the Attendance Policy.
- k. If the student has four absences already on record, and additional absences occur, they will have to be excused at the instructor's discretion. An emergency can be defined as a sickness, family emergency, or family crisis.
- l. Situation beyond the limit of the policies or privilege of the instructor can be appealed. You will have to be evaluated for an appeal and scheduled a meeting with the president.

Note: Any official class closing will not be counted as an absence. This may include inclement weather, holidays, etc. However, to maintain your grade, the assignment must be completed per course schedule.

3. Courses

- * At the end of each course, each student will be responsible for turning in each course assignment on scheduled date.

- * If the assignment is not completed, the instructor has the authority to drop your grade by 5 points each week the assignment is overdue.

- * The instructor, when grading the assignment, will consider class participation.

- * Legibility will be considered when grading. College level quality is required.

- * Each student will be responsible for writing an essay or thesis based upon degree level which is 12.5 % of your entire grade. If it is not completed by the deadline given, the instructor has the authority to deduct your grade by 10 %.

Policy and Commandments (continued)

Change of Grade

It is the student's responsibility to retain all assignments, quizzes, and exams until final grades are received in the event an error in calculating or reporting a grade has been made. In the case of such an error, the student should immediately present his/her case to the instructor. If warranted, the instructor will then initiate a change of grade in the office of admissions and records. The deadline for a grade change request is six weeks after the close of a semester. The academic dean must approve all change of grades.

Incomplete Grades

And "I" incomplete grade is given when a student, due to illness or an emergency situation beyond their control is unable to complete their final project or final exam before the end of semester. Work must be turned in within two weeks from the close of the semester; otherwise, the student will receive a failure "F" for the incomplete work. The final grade will be adjusted according to the average of the course work and the final "O" grade.

Examination

Students receive a syllabus for each course they are enrolled. Students are responsible for noting the dates on which the instructor has scheduled quizzes, exams, mid-terms, and/or finals. If a student has three unexcused absences, the instructor has the authority to drop your grade by one level.

Make Up Policy

All exams must be made up within five days of the date of the original exam (excluding weekends).

1) Illness

In case of illness, the student must notify the administration/dean of school his/her illness.

2) Non - Illness

Students who miss an exam for non-illness reasons should make an appointment with their professor to make up the exam. Student not making up the exam within the prescribed time period will receive a "O".

Criteria for Transfer of Credit (Pastors Only)

To acquire an Associate Degree with Pastoral Experience:

- * Fill out the admission application.
- * You will need to obtain your high school transcript or copy of your diploma.
- * Submit a portfolio of your life experiences as it relates to your life in the church.
- * When all of the above information is submitted to the school and received by the Board of Directors of Faith in Action Bible College, and upon approval, you will be awarded the Associate Degree by Faith in Action Bible College.

To Acquire a Bachelor Degree with Pastoral Experience:

- * Fill out the admission application.
- * You will need to obtain your high school transcript or copy of your diploma.
- * Submit a copy of all transcripts, degrees and certificates from all schools of study.
- * Submit a portfolio of your life experiences as it relates to your life in the church.
- * When all of the above information is submitted to the school and revised by the Board of Directors of Faith in Action Bible College, and upon approval, you will be awarded the Bachelor Degree by Faith in Action Bible College.

NOTE: The difference between the Associates and Bachelor Degree will be based on the years of pastoral experience and transfer credit.

To acquire a Master Degree with Pastoral Experience:

- * If you have a Bachelor's Degree in Arts/Science or religious studies/divinity from an accredited college, you may be able to advance to the Master's Degree in Theology.
- * You will need to submit all transcripts, degrees and certifications from all schools of study.
- * Submit your portfolio of your life experiences as it relates to your life in the church.
- * This evaluation will be at the discretion of the FIABC President.

Doctoral Degree: Students seeking their Doctoral Degree will be required to schedule an appointment with the FIABC President (Dr. Apostle Amoy D. Baker) to further discuss criteria and requirements.

Criteria for Transfer of Credits (Students)

To those who have a Bachelor of Arts and Science Degree:

- * Transcript Documents: The Board of Governors of the Universities of North Carolina, who certified FIABC and AICCS Accrediting Commission, will only fully recognize an official transcript for the approval of transfer of credit hours. For additional credits; certifications and other documentation will be evaluated and assigned to life experience. Official transcript give you a better opportunity for one-to-one transfer of credit hours.
- * Students who already possess a four-year degree from another approved accredited college or university with a grade of “C” or better, with church life experience, he or she may be eligible to acquire an Associate Degree in Biblical Studies and advance to the Bachelor degree in Theology program.
- * Students interested in transferring with existing credits should fill out an application and have official transcripts and a copy of their diploma/certificate, and church life experience sent to the Administration Office of FIABC, with the request that a complete evaluation be performed. Evaluations are not automatically performed.
- * Final processing and evaluation will be done through Faith in Action Bible College along with the president of FIABC. You will be notified by letter of approval or disapproval.

NOTE: FIABC values the experience gained through “church life-experience”. We ask that the student submit a portfolio of their life experiences as it relates to his/her life in the church/ministry.

Doctoral Degree Program

If you have enough transfer credits for a Master Degree or possess a Master Degree in Biblical Studies, Theology, or Divinity, you will be eligible to receive a Master Degree and will be enrolled in the Doctoral Program (with the required dissertation).

Degree Program Thesis/ Essay

All students must complete the Biblical Studies Workbook along with the prescribed course of the portable textbooks for each degree level.

Additional Criteria for Degree Program Thesis/Essay

- **Associate Program** – complete an additional 2000-word minimum essay, with three required research references. Associate Degree is in Biblical Studies only.
- **Bachelor Program** – complete an additional 3500-word minimum essay, with four Required research references.
- **Master Program 1st Year** – complete an additional 5500-word minimum essay, with five required research references.
- **Master Program 2nd Year** – complete an additional 7500-word minimum word essay, with six required research references. The required thesis will be directly related to the degree that you will earn. Whether Divinity, Christian Ministry, Theology, etc.
- All essay and thesis papers that are written from any published books must be re-titled and written based on the Biblical Principles and scripture Reference of the book.
- All thesis papers must abide by the following guidelines:
 - Cover Sheet
 - Title Page
 - Abstract (150-200 words)
 - Table of Contents
 - An Introduction (that include a clear statement of the topic)
 - Review of the Literature
 - A Conclusion
 - References
 - Number pages (at the bottom)
 - 12 Point Font
 - Ariel (Times New Roman)
 - Double Space
- All thesis papers are due by the end of the second semester. Please refer to your class schedule for specific dates. Final paper should be submitted according to posted deadline. Writing should be free of grammatical errors and plagiarism.
- Information in the paper should use the appropriate evidence to support conclusions drawn. Final paper should demonstrate critical thinking skills and knowledge of the subject.

The Biblical Studies degree provides students with an understanding of the history, context and message of the Bible in an online format. In addition, this degree teaches the historical and theological developments within a framework of Christianity. Prepare to pursue seminary or graduate studies in the bible, theology, church history and related fields.

The Masters in Biblical Studies provides a strong foundation for various kinds of Christian services. It is designed primarily for lay leaders who desire training for better ministry within their church or organization, and may also provide supplemental training for parachurch workers in mission agencies or churches.

This program meets the educational requirements for ordained ministry in most major Protestant denominations. Within the framework of curriculum of required course work in biblical studies, history, theology, ethics, field education, formation for leadership, cultural resources for ministry, and ministerial practices for leadership. We encourage students to pursue an understanding of their own faith tradition in light of global, ecumenical, and inter-disciplinary concerns, institutions, and movements represented at FIABC.

The Association of Theological Schools has established that the purpose of the Master in biblical studies is “to equip persons for competent leadership in some form of specialized ministry in congregations and other settings.”

Educational and spiritual Goals of these studies is to enable students to:

1. Demonstrate a general knowledge of the Bible, including a synthetic understanding of the major books.
2. Provide an understanding of the historical development of theology, knowledge of premillennial theology, and an ability to support their theological views and apply them to contemporary issues.
3. Demonstrate an increasing involvement in the local church or other ministries with which they are associate minster within a local church or other group by means of leadership skills, evangelism, and service.

The FIABC Doctorate Degree Program

When a student reaches the Doctoral level, he or she reached a level where course study is no longer a challenge. The student is required to submit a 50, 000-word positional dissertation in his or her chosen field of study. This dissertation must be type-written and bound.

*** The dissertation MUST be defended before the Review Board!***
Defending Dissertation: Last Monday in April beginning at 6:00 pm

All students receiving a Doctoral Degree are required to purchase, robe, hood and a tam and must attend the FIABC graduation. The Doctoral graduation fees should be prepaid and submitted with tuition.

THE DOCTORAL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This college has been designed for the perfecting of the saints. The necessity of this program is to enhance the intellectual challenges and theology for the students that qualify.

Each candidate for the doctoral program is expected to achieve expert knowledge as well as an outstanding ability of conducting research and documentation.

Goals and Objectives: The proposed doctoral program intends:

- To make use of the resources that Faith in Action Bible College has to offer and prepare individuals who are capable of thinking creativity about the principles of teaching the Bible on a college level.
- Course Work in this program will consist of submitting a well written and well researched dissertation.
- The student must be able to prepare and defend the subject matter that they are writing about.

Credits and Course of Study: The doctoral program requires a minimum of 231 credit hours preferably with a master Degree however:

- The Acceptance of other degree study programs from previous universities and colleges may be considered.
- You may have a rich Pastoral and Ministry History that will need to be reviewed by the President of FIABC respectively.

The FIABC Doctorate Degree Program (continued)

To complete the doctoral program, it will take one year of study and submission of the assigned dissertation work. Students who have not completed their degree within the academic year after the approval of the dissertation proposal must petition the President of FIABC. Upon successful completion of all assigned work, the student will be evaluated for candidacy of the Doctoral Degree.

Admission to the Doctoral Degree Program

In general, the admission process follows standards of FIABC procedures. Admission into the doctoral program is based on the applicant's academic record, letters of recommendation, the Master's Degree record and a brief written essay of why they want to enter into the doctor degree program.

In the essay, applicant will:

1. Articulate the nature of their interest in Doctoral Degree Program.
2. Outlined their education has provided preparation to further their studies.
A master's degree is required for admission; however, students holding a range of degrees, other studies, certificates from a variety of programs will be considered.

The Doctorate Degree: A Doctoral candidate can obtain a Doctorate Degree in their specific field of study. For example, the Doctorate in Theology is called. Doctor of Theology, abbreviated **D.TH., Th.D., D. Theol., or Dr. theol.** **Business Administration** is called a **DBS.** All these and many more degrees are Doctoral degrees as they are considered to be the highest learning points in these fields of study.

Part One

Part one of the Faith in Action Bible College Doctoral Program consists of twenty-four units of seminars and directed reading, including a methods seminar foundational course. After twenty-four units have been completed, students will take a comprehensive examination based on course study and seminars.

Part two

Part two consists of completing twenty-eight units of research, development, compiling and composing the doctoral dissertation. Candidates may also be required to defend their dissertation based on the validity of their research and subsequent decision of the doctoral Advisory Board; therefore, submission of an initial or rough draft is essential.
